WINES

WHITE

CIELO TREBBIANO PINOT GRIGIO, ITALY

A light and clean wine with citrus fruit notes and a hint of melon and mango giving a little richness. Established in 1908 Cielo is now run by the fourth generation family members. Over the years they have grown from just a small vineyard holding to a family winery with international demand.

DOMAINE CASTELNAU, PICPOUL DE PINET, FRANCE

On the doorstep of the village of Castelnaud de Guers, the Domaine de Castelnaud lies, dating back to the 13th century. Béatrice and Christophe Muret have been lovingly tending to their legacy since 1997 carrying on their forefather's vocation. They harvest their grapes at full maturity at night to preserve quality. Their wines are certified with Protected Designations of Origin and Protected Geographical Indications.

STONEBURN SAUVIGNON BLANC, NEW ZEALAND

A combination of fresh gooseberry fruit with underlying passionfruit flavours and a long complex finish. Jane Hunter has been one of the most influential people in the New Zealand Wine industry. Established in 1978, they were amongst the first and now have worldwide recognition for the quality of their wines.

MONT AURIOL VIOGNIER, FRANCE

Aromatic in style, elegant floral apricot notes, full and rich with underlying tropical fruit notes. Situated close to the Mediterranean Sea, the vineyard has belonged to the Sarret family for thirteen generations. Sustainable growing with no herbicides are used, but organic fertilisers with biodynamic culture.

ADEGA DE MONCAO VINHO VERDE, PORTUGAL

Crisp citrus aromas, lime and peach notes, followed by a refreshing spritz on a long finish. Moncao winery was founded on the 11th October in 1958 thanks to the initiative of 25 wine growers. This successful cooperative has gone from strength to strength now farming just over 1200 hectares involving over 1600 small growers.

ZERBO GAVI, ITALY

Quality, personality and great wines, this is Il Rocchin Gavi today, the farm founded by the Zerbo family. The company has always put the territory at the centre of its project with the aim of enhancing the history and culture related to the local grapes. It extends over 100 hectares, 44 of which are planted with vines, dedicated to the production of Barbera and Gavi wine.

LES CLASSIQUES MACON, BURGUNDY FRANCE

Crisp apple notes, off dry with a refreshing mineral finish. Located in Vergisson, a picturesque village perched up high in the hills at the heart of the historic Solutre and Vergisson site, in southern Burgundy. The vineyards stretch over 6 hectares in two appellations, Pouilly Fuse and Saint-Veran.

ROSÉ

LA COLOMBETTE GRENACHE ROSÉ, FRANCE

Fruity, soft and rounded with sweet berry aromas, off dry with delicate notes of crushed red fruits, divine. Domaine La Colombette can trace its roots back to 1890, when Louis Pugibet was given his first hectare of vines as a wedding gift from his wife. Four generations later the family is still going strong winning endless awards for their wines. For them wine is a constant source of inspiration and innovation.

RED

CANFO TEMPRANILLO, LA MANCHA, SPAIN

Vibrant with an intense cherry colour and flavours of ripe blackberries and raspberries. Campo Reales is based in the North East of La Mancha. With a modern approach and new wine making techniques they have won numerous awards for their wines over the years.

LONG COUNTRY MERLOT, CHILE

Enticing dark fruits on the nose, juicy blackcurrant notes on the palate dance with spicy undertones. It all began in 1851 when a young Silvestre Ochagavia started a revolution in national wine making by planting the first French varieties in Santiago. With more than 165 years of existence and pioneers of Chilean viticulture. Vina Ochagavia creates distinctive and passionate wines for the world to enjoy.

DOMAINE LA COLOMBETTE PINOT NOIR, PAYS D'HERAULT, FRANCE

Ripe cherry and redcurrant notes with hints of spice pushing through on a delicious soft finish. Domaine La Colombette can trace its roots back to 1890, when Louis Pugibet was given his first hectare of vines as a wedding gift from his wife. Four generations later the family is still going strong winning endless awards for their wines. For them wine is a constant source of inspiration and innovation.

CALDORA MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO, ITALY

Rich dark bramble fruits, soft tannins with an enticing warm finish. Born from the co-op, Cantina Sociale di Ortona, Caldora is based in the province of Chieti in Italy's Abruzzo region. This is a historic cooperative with over 1500 hectares of cultivated land and around 700 farmers.

SPARKLING

CIELO SPUMANTE PROSECCO, ITALY

Richly fruity, with white flower aromas. Ripe fruit flavours with notes of peach and apricot, delicious. Established in 1908 Cielo is now run by the fourth generation family members. Over the years they have grown from just a small vineyard holding to a family winery with international demand.

CAMEL VALLEY SPARKLING ROSÉ, CORNWALL

Expressive yet delicate strawberry fruit aromas, off dry with enticing summer fruits and beautiful structure. Bob and Annie Lindo planted their first eight thousand vines in 1989, they have been a phenomenal success for Cornish wine and have been awarded a Royal Warrant.
